Beth H. Mitchell, a partner in Nutter's Real Estate and Finance Department and co-chair of the firm's Commercial Finance practice group, will present on the "Let's Get This Project Built — What's the Market in Construction Lending Today?" panel at the "Intermediate Real Estate Financing" webinar on March 30. The panelists will focus on how construction finance requires an understanding of the project and the issues that concern the developer, as well as the lender's concerns and ways to mitigate the lender's risk.

The webinar will address:

- Proper overview of construction loan checklist and legal issues arising during due diligence
 - Zoning compliance, getting utilities to the site, development agreements, and the development process
- Third party construction agreements
 - Assignments of contracts, certifications, and consents
 - Mechanic's liens: subordination, title coverage, bonding, and subcontractor default insurance
- The Draw Process: Draw requests, change orders, budget reallocation, loan balancing, and the role of lender's inspector
- Payment and completion guaranties
